

Acceptance conditions for scrap delivery/removal.

Be denied:

1. Objects such as tanks, drums, gas cylinders that are unopened or not been cleaned. (Manholes should be open at a tank)
2. KGA (small hazardous)
3. Radioactive material
4. Ammunition except empty cartridges and empty canisters if supplied separately
5. Machines that have not been drained of their system fluids (oil, coolant, etc.)
6. Engines of cars and trucks that are not depolluted and, in general, any non-depolluted equipment, which contains liquids (e.g. forklift)
7. Transformers (excluding transformers that have been de-oiled and provided they have contained only mineral oil, i.e. not PCB-containing oil, with analyses)
8. WEEE (Waste Electrical and Electronic Equipment) that has not been depolluted (e.g. presence of capacitor containing PCB or PTC, refrigerant gas, etc.).
9. Batteries
excluded :
 - Batteries to be deposited in WEEE (WEEE delivered separately)
 - Lead batteries and batteries in forklift delivered separately
 - Small batteries (hand size) deposited by the supplier himself in the receptacles provided for that purpose. (bicycle batteries, AA batteries,...)
10. Material containing PCBs
11. Self-igniting/self-igniting powders/products (e.g., magnesium, aluminum powder, etc.)
12. Products containing asbestos and/or ceramic fibers
13. Fire cases/vaults unless it can be shown that they not asbestos-containing.
14. Liquids

Car/light cargo belt delivered between/in the scrap metal	10Kg
Truck tire delivered between/in the scrap metal	100Kg
Other tires between/in the scrap delivered	According to estimated weight.
Gas cylinders delivered between/in the scrap metal	Butane/Propane €100/piece Other: €500/piece
All other nonconforming materials between/in the scrap delivered.	Actual processing cost+ €100.
